

Engineer 1 / Engineering Technician

The Lynn Water & Sewer Commission (LWSC) is seeking a qualified individual for the position of Engineer 1 / Engineering Technician in the LWSC Engineering Department. This employee will perform a wide variety of technical functions, relating to various aspects of water and sewer infrastructure under the direct supervision of the Chief Engineer.

An ideal candidate should be a fast independent learner who is well organized; can easily multi-task; has an attention to detail, and is a strong problem solver. They must also have excellent communication skills to engage with both the public and industry professionals, and be able to work under pressure as a team member while maintaining a professional attitude and appearance.

Skills: Applicants must have a strong background with Geographic Information Systems (GIS) using ArcGIS Software, and be proficient in Excel. Familiarity with computerized maintenance management systems (CMMS) is preferred but not required.

Duties: May include but not limited to the following: GIS Data Management, interpretation and digitizing of engineering plans, input and retrieval of computer data, records management (digital and hard copy), preparation of documents for and / or reporting to state or federal authorities, and the collection of water and sewer infrastructure data in the field for database input.

Qualifications: Applicants with less than 2 years of experience must hold a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university, preferably in Civil Engineering, Environmental Science, or similar. Applicants with two or more years of experience must hold an Associate's Degree in Engineering Technology, GIS, Surveying, or similar, and have experience in the municipal sector or with water / sewer infrastructure and / or State and Federal regulations. A Valid EIT/FE certificate is also preferred.

Salary: A competitive salary commensurate with ability and experience in all phases of responsibilities. LWSC offers a full benefits package including educational reimbursement, and is an Equal Opportunity Employer.
